Meals-to-You



- Three-year demonstration project spanning 2019-2021 to mail meals to FRP-eligible children in rural communities
 - Year 1 – Served 488,940 meals and snacks to children in 20 TX school districts
 - Year 2 plans – expand Meals-to-You to select communities in New Mexico and Alaska.
- Then the pandemic hit...

Meals-to-You

- Difficulty in sourcing diverse food items. Requirement for shelf stable, competition with other food distributors (groceries, schools, etc)
- Shipping to rural areas already difficult, add to that an overall national increase in e-commerce = a delay in delivery.
- Address validation issues; bottom of the grand canyon, other rural areas where addresses are atypical
